rehabilitation medical camps were organized by Community Based Rehabilitation team. First camp was organized on 27.11.2019 in



Majhwa block, the second camp in KVM in kasha Vidyapeeth block on 28.11.2019 and the third camp on 29.11.2019 in Sikhad block. Total 102 children and persons with disabilities were assessed in these camps. 32 children were assessed for General Movement and 70 were assessed for Neuro and disabilities. 17 children out of 70 were referred for further medical test. Five children with disabilities and their parents from three blocks have also been selected for parents training program. Dr. Christa Einspieler, Professor of Physiology at University of Graz (Austria) contributed in these camps. Susann Mösle-Hüppi, President of KIRAN Foundation Switzerland has also visited the camps.
