The KIRAN vocation skills program will continue to be improved so that youth with disabilities have better opportunities to earn a living.



A LITTLE WISH, A LOT OF HOPE

In rural Varanasi and Mirzapur, KIRAN is implementing ATMANIRBHAR with the support of IM Sweden. This program provides vocational training for youth with disabilities and from the marginalized.

These youth are paving the way to a dignified livelihood with technical skills training in trades such as Mobile Repairing, Blood Collection, Worm compost, Spice Making, Tailoring, Beautician.

To complement their technical skills, a soft skill training was organised to build self confidence in trainees. Prahalad is a young man who has been in a wheelchair since he was born. He never allows his situation to hold him back and is always working hard to use his athletic abilities to the best of his abilities.

Prahalad received much needed support from KIRAN society to pursue his dream of representing India in Para Games.

He is now preparing for national para games which he had qualified after winning at state level games.
